The Belleau Wood Match is an As-Issued Military Rifle Match (Course A) where participants are encouraged to use a rifle representative of those fielded by combatants of WWI (M1903, M1917, No 1 Mk 3, M98, French Label, etc), and will be fired immediately after the D-Day Match.

In all slow fire stages with the M1 Carbine, competitors may load from a magazine. No more than five rounds may be loaded in a single magazine. If the Carbine is taken down from the shoulder between shots, care must be taken to keep the muzzle pointed downrange while resting with a loaded rifle.

MARYLAND STATE SERVICE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

Hosted by the FORT HILL RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB

21-22 September 2013 CMP Sanctioned

1. RANGE LOCATION: The Warrior Mountain Range of the Fort Hill Rifle and Pistol Club, located off of Cresap Mill Road in Oldtown, Maryland. Coordinates to the gated entrance = N 39 36.874' W 78 39.292' From Interstate 68 east or west take Cumberland exit 43B Industrial Blvd / MD 51 south. Proceed 11.5 miles on MD 51 south and turn left onto Cresap Mill Road. Proceed 3.5 miles to Fort Hill Rifle & Pistol Club gate on right, just past the large power lines. The range gate will open at 6:30 AM each day.
2. RULES: This championship will be governed by the 17th Edition CMP Competition Rules (2013) <http://www.odcmp.com/Competitions/Rulebook.pdf> In the interest of time, NO DOUBLE ALIBIS will be allowed for any reason.
3. ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual.
4. AUTHORIZED FIREARMS: Rifles that comply with Rule 6.2.1 U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1; Rule 6.2.2 U.S. Rifle, Caliber 7.62mm NATO (.308 Win), M14; or Rule 6.2.3 U.S. Rifle, Caliber 5.56mm, M16. Triggers will be weighed prior to squadding.
5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED. Range capacity for this championship is 40 competitors. Walk on entries may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only.
6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry using the enclosed Registration & Entry Form or through the on-line registration at <http://www.fhrpc.org/servicerifle/>

7. ENTRIES CLOSE: Individual entries close Wednesday, 18 September 2013, or whenever range capacity is met. Entries received after 18 September 2013 or after range capacity is initially met may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only.

8. FEES: \$40 for Championship (\$20 for the Full Course Service Rifle Match; \$20 for EIC match).
CHALLENGE FEE: \$3.00.

9. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the 300-yard line starting no later than 8:00 AM each day. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 8:30 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies.

10. TARGET SERVICE: Target pullers will not be provided. Competitors will pull their own targets.

11. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform their scoring duties may be disqualified.

12. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): An NRA-approved empty chamber indicator is required to be in your rifle except during the preparation period or firing of your relay.

13. INCLEMENT WEATHER: The Championship will continue to run in mild to moderate rain.

14. AWARDS: FHRPC will present plaques to the following competitors:

- Maryland State Service Rifle Overall Champion
- Maryland State Service Rifle 2nd Place
- Maryland State Service Rifle 3rd Place

FHRPC will present plaques to the following competitors if there are eligible entrants in each category:

- Highest aggregate scoring Junior (21-)
- Highest aggregate scoring Senior (60+)
- Highest aggregate scoring Woman

CMP will award State Championship Medallions to the top 3 finishers. Additionally, CMP will award EIC points/medals for the EIC match.

No cash prizes will be awarded for this Championship.

15. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends 1/2 hour after the posting of the match results.

16. MATCH SCHEDULE: The Maryland State Service Rifle Championship will be determined from the 1,300-point aggregate score of the two-day event:
